The weekend will consist of a practical workshop **for trainers who want to plan  
and realize trainings for authorities to raise awareness for the intersection  
of LGBTTIQ and Migration / Asylum / Flight and who already have experi-  
ence with working with authorities** on Saturday and the opportunity to start-  
working on their own concept with other participants on Sunday.

Friday evening is reserved for an "Erzählcafe" where participants will get to know  
each other as well as share experiences and challenges that arise in their respective  
contexts and fields of work. Saturday will be entirely filled with the workshop "train-  
ing concepts for authorities and general agency staff". The aim of this workshop is to  
raise awareness for the specific parameters needed for offering workshops for  
government and other officials and to give participants practice oriented impulses  
for their own training concepts. These will take into account both needs of NGOs  
and self-organizations as well as the specific structures and cultures within govern-  
ment agencies. The facilitators will share their experiences from a previous aware-  
ness training on the intersection of LGBTTIQ and Migration / Asylum / Flight within  
a municipal agency as well as offer didactic methods to achieve workshop goals in  
regards to knowledge transfer, reflection/awareness raising and practice transfer.  
At the end of Saturday the participants will be able to develop their own training con-  
cept and draw from the foundations laid built during the workshop if they conduct  
their own training.
